



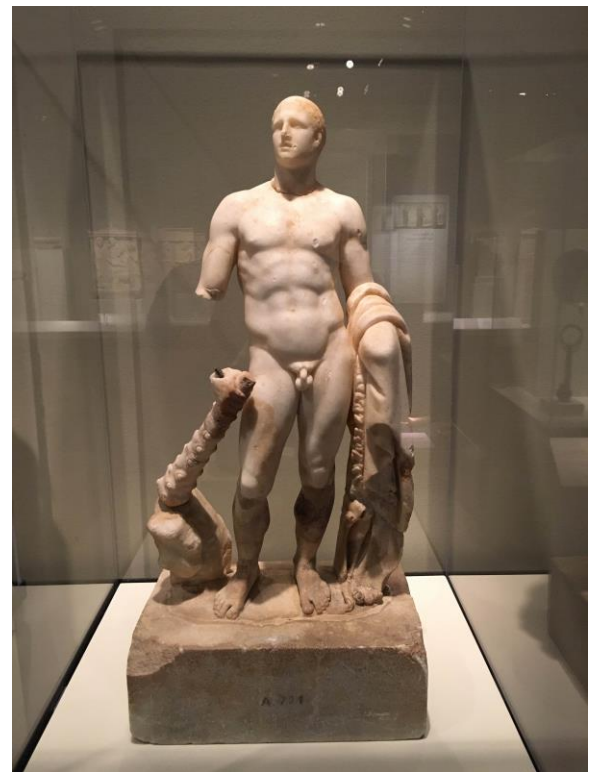

The Greeks at the Field Museum: Ancient Greece in the Modern World

Philosophers, soldiers, athletes, kings, priests & heroes: these are the people we think of when we hear “Ancient Greece”. All too often, modern audiences overlook the social & cultural diversity of the peoples living in the ancient Aegean. Now, a travelling exhibition currently at the Field Museum grapples with the social complexities & perspectives of these people, displaying material spanning thousands of years from all over the Aegean. Many of these objects have never been shown outside of Greece before.

Samuel Howes, a veteran scholar of Classical Studies & docent at the Field Museum, will share his perspective on Greek archaeology in today’s museums. Using *The Greeks* exhibit at the Field Museum as a general framework, he will explain how an exhibit on Classical archaeology is developed, what we can understand about people from the things they have left behind & ultimately, how we can approach similar exhibits throughout the world.
