"Linguistic Baggage": A Global Examination of Adult Accent Training in English as a Second Language (ESL) Classrooms

The Question is: How do language classrooms around the world treat accent differentiation and does their treatment oppose how linguistic research concludes language classrooms should treat it?

The study examines data from 6 ESL language schools in 6 different countries to determine whether classroom practices around accent differentiation correlate with how linguistic research recommends its treatment. Accent differentiation is the frequency and amount of different accents students hear in the classroom. Mackenzie traveled to: Cusco, Peru; Málaga, Spain; Prague, Czech Republic; Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia; and Melbourne, Australia plus interviewing with a school in Hiroshima, Japan.
